



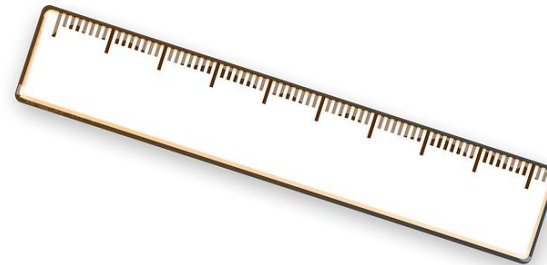
Fun with Font |

This activity is to create a 'one point perspective' 3d word. Follow the step-by-step instructions to create your very own word art!



You will need:

- A piece of white paper
- A pencil
- A rubber
- A black pen
- A ruler (or something with a straight edge)
- Some colouring pens or pencils

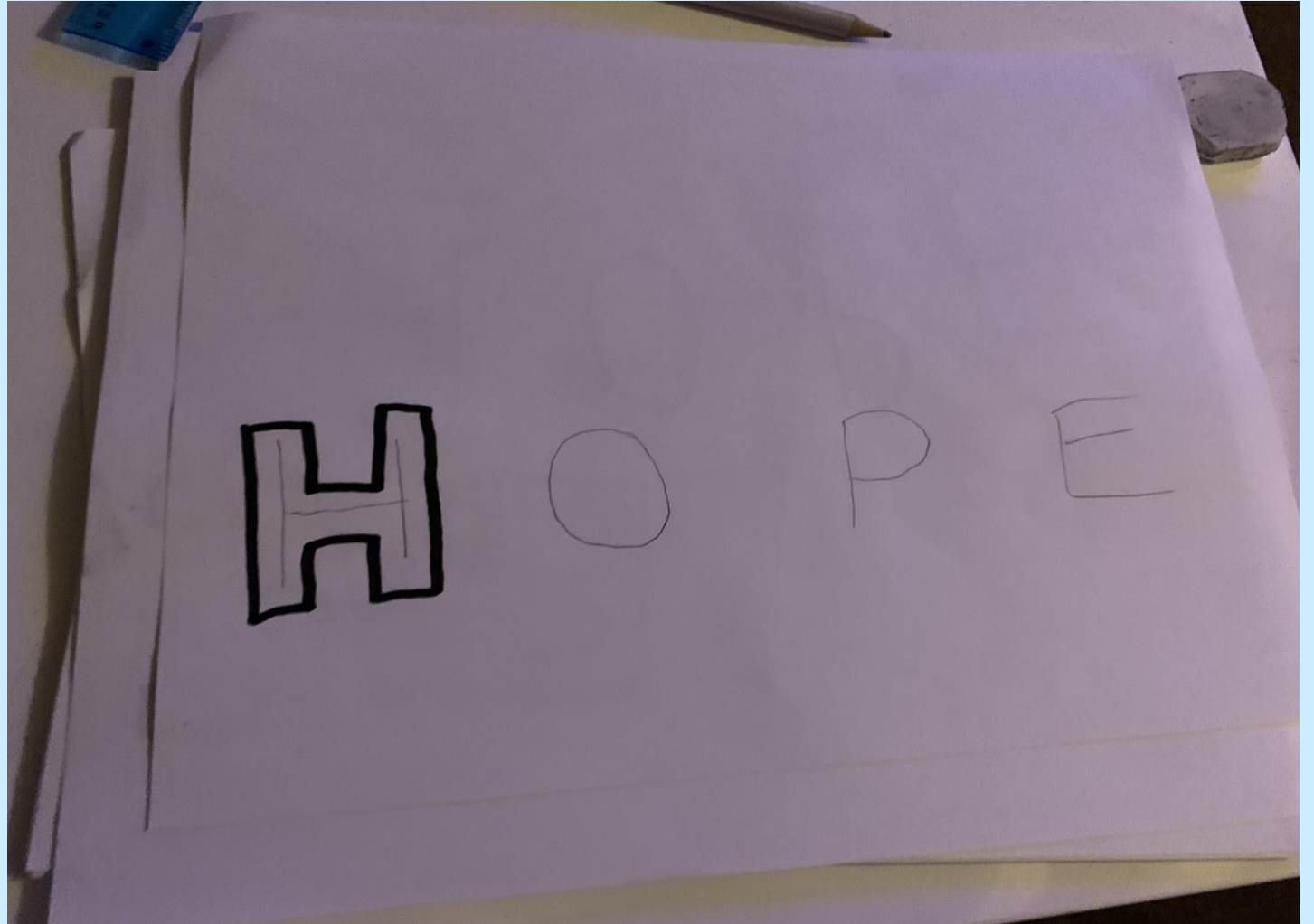


Step 1: Choose an inspirational word – there are some examples below to help you

DREAM BRAVE INSPIRE
HOPE JOY THINK
SMILE
AMBITION BELIEVE
KIND HAPPY LOVE

(Step 2) Start off by lightly drawing a word (as we will erase it later), in my case, I wrote out "HOPE". Do whatever word you choose.

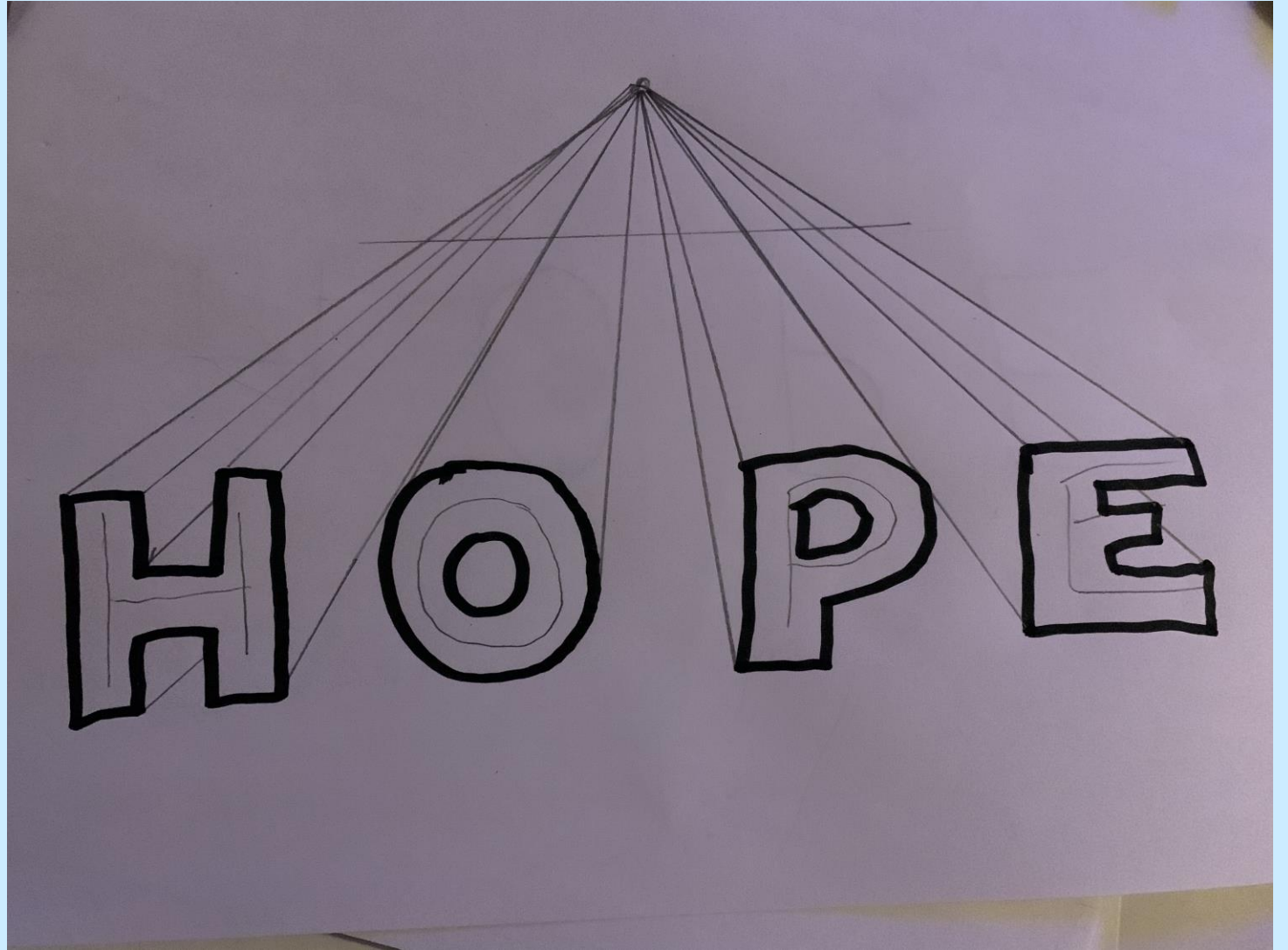
(Step 3) Now outline the letters, by drawing around your lines so that you make block letters. You can rub out the original letters now...so that you just have block letters left



(Step 4) Lightly draw a dot at the top of your page as close to the middle as possible. (This mark will be your vanishing point.)

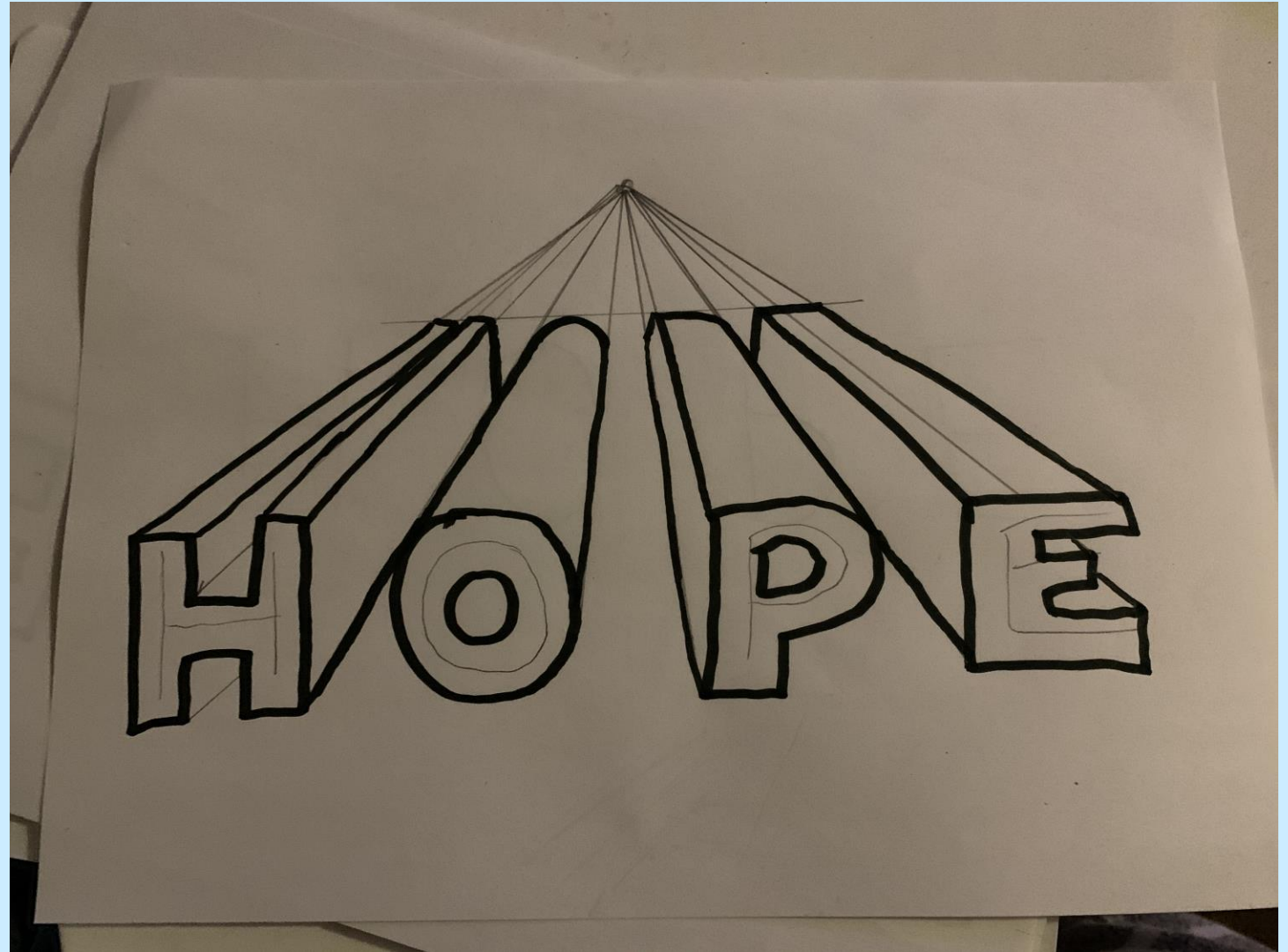
(Step 5) Now draw lines from the letters to the vanishing point. Make sure you use a ruler – every outside corner of every letter will need to have a line joining it to the point. This will give them a 3D effect.

(Step 6) Draw a light line where you want your letters to end. The top of your letters in the distance will be parallel to your block lettering.



(Step 7) Once you know where you want your letters to end, use the lines you have drawn to draw a horizontal line (or curved line in the case of the letter 'o' and 'p') for each letter.

(Step 8) Use your ruler to finish your straight edged letters and join them up to the face of your letter.



(Step 9) Once you've outlined your letters in pen, erase all your pencil lines with a rubber.

(Step 10) Decorate your letters however you would like! Contrasting, bold colours tend to work very well.
