- It takes place in March or April.

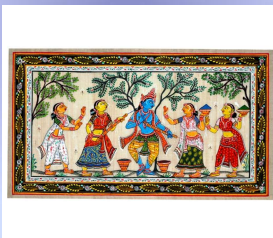


How do Hindus celebrate Holi?

- People throw coloured water or paint at passers by.
- People are allowed to be rude to those they normally respect. For instance, pupils may throw things at teachers!!!
