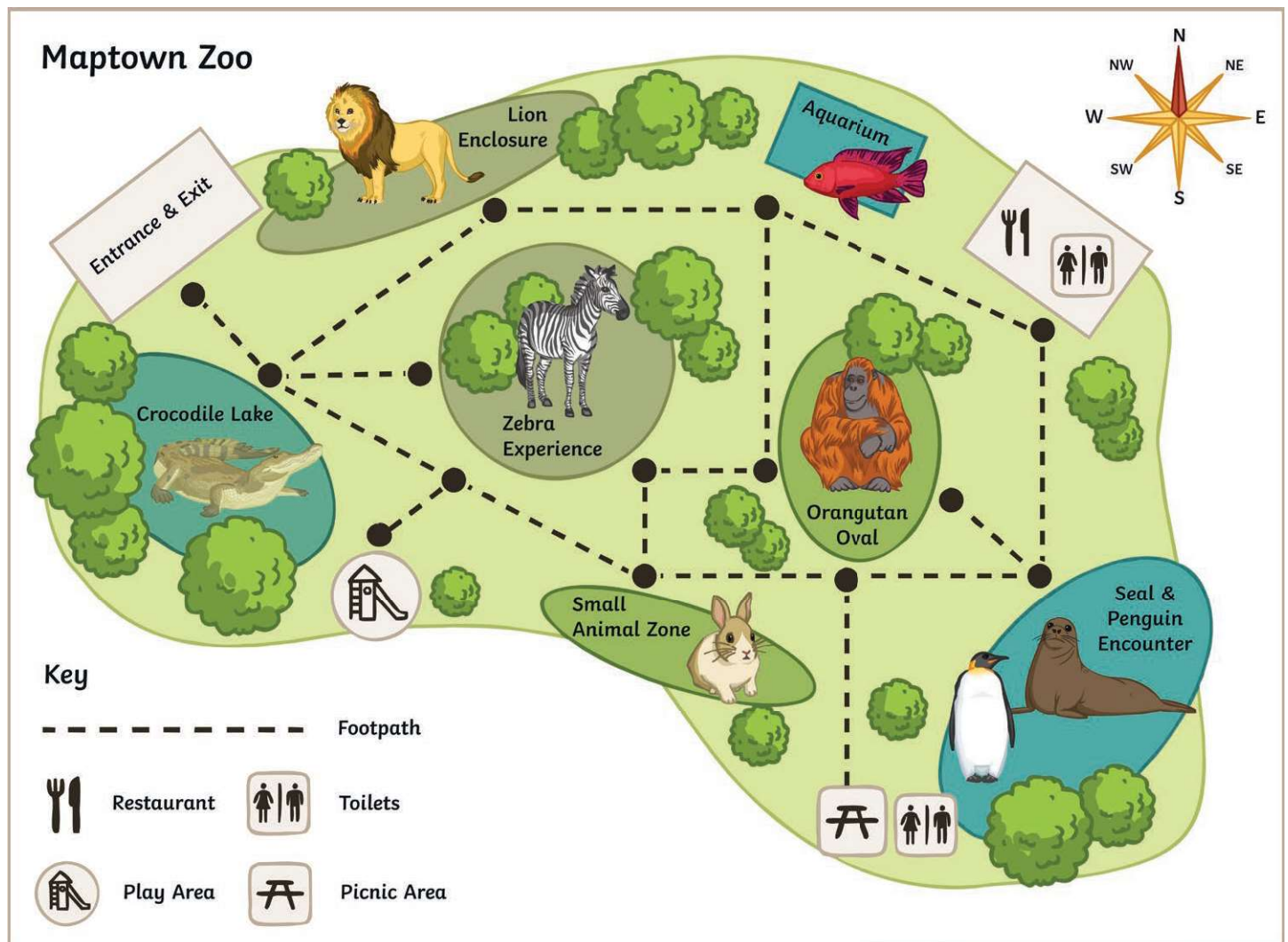


Maptown Zoo

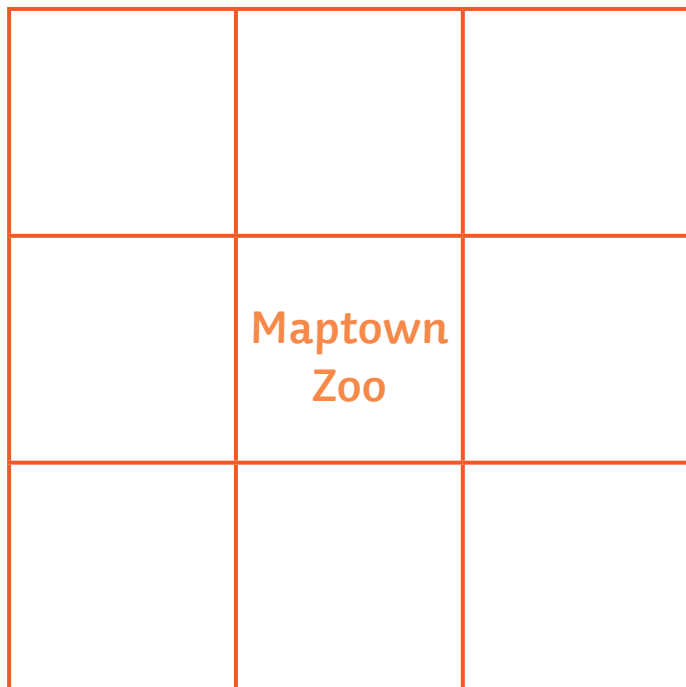
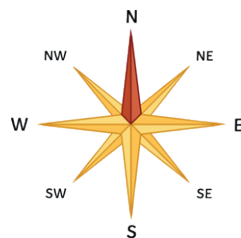
Extension Task
