Rationale

Head and Deputy Head have responsibility for overall leadership and management of the school. This is measured by self-evaluation of the school's effectiveness. This is reported to governor's on a regular basis, mainly through Curriculum Committee. The performance of these key staff is reviewed by governor's each year.

Leadership Team, established following discussion within Personnel Committee and aimed to link leadership and management directly to School Improvement. Key staff each have responsibility for annual School Improvement areas. Effect reviewed through the school year and within Appraisal cycle. Senior Leadership Team meet regularly primarily to discuss strategic directions for the school.

SEND Coordinator is an increasingly important role within school. The role encompasses identification and support for children with needs. This included regular review of children requiring intervention support, linked to the Personalised learning agenda.

Teachers have been appointed to cover 11 classes of children. The admission number for the school is 50. In reception we have 2 classes, with a maximum of 25 children in each. In KS1, we have 3 classes, a Year 1 class, a Year 2 class and a mixed age Year 1/2 class. All KS1 classes are a maximum of 30 children, as is legally required. In KS2 up to 200 children are in 6 classes which involves two mixed age classes for Year 3/4 and year 5/6.

These decisions require a teaching staff of 15 (13 class teachers plus the Headteacher and Deputy Head).
