I am aware that over the coming week lots of you will be purchasing school uniform for September. With this letter, I am attaching the School Uniform Policy.

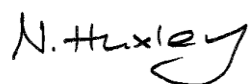
However, I would just like to point out a few areas that sometimes give children difficulties if parents don't buy the correct uniform or follow the school policy. Can parents pay particular attention to the information around 'girls' leggings and cycle shorts':

- Children must have velcro shoes if they cannot tie laces themselves. This is usually vital in Reception and KS1.
- On PE days, children must come to school with velcro trainers if they cannot tie laces themselves. This is usually vital in Reception and KS1.
- Children should have a pair of pumps that are to be left in school for the times they do dance and gymnastics in the school hall. If children don't have pumps they have to do these areas of PE barefooted. Please ensure that your child's pumps are named.
- For PE days, children should wear plain navy jogging bottoms, plain navy leggings or plain navy shorts. Branded items like Nike or Adidas are not allowed.
- Girls may wear navy blue cycle shorts, which can be bought in all supermarkets, however, these should be at least mid-thigh length for modesty.
- Black shorts or leggings, are not part of our uniform.
- No jewellery (bracelets, chains etc) is allowed to be worn by children in school other than a wrist watch. Wrist watches must not be able to access photos or the internet; no SMART WATCHES.
- No earrings or studs are allowed in school. We do allow the 'plastic safety studs.
- Hair. Long hair must be secured appropriately with simple, plain, hair bands or bobbles. These should be blue or red in keeping with school colours.
- Sensible haircuts only. No tram lines or extreme shaved styles.
- Sensible Black School Shoes (not trainers or boots). Sports brands like Nike or Adidas are not allowed. For Health and Safety reasons girls' shoes must have either a supporting strap or laces and not be the slip on type.
- Coats should be plain, warm and rainproof.

It is absolutely vital that all children have the full Town Green uniform for the start of the new academic year (2025/26) so that we can ensure our standards of uniform remain of the highest quality.

As with all other areas of school, we expect very high standards and encourage children to take pride in their appearance so please support us with this matter.
